

Publication terms and conditions accompanying use of Radboud Biobank biomaterial and data

It is important that the Radboud Biobank has a complete and up-to-date list of publications in which the biomaterial and data were provided by the Radboud Biobank. In this manner the value of the Radboud Biobank as a central biobank facility can be demonstrated. Biomaterial and data from the Radboud Biobank are only distributed under the condition that in every form of publication the Radboud Biobank is mentioned as the source and if applicable the name “Radboud Biobank” is mentioned in the Methods section.
