Application procedure

- Nominations should be sent to <u>rimls.info@radboudumc.nl</u> at the latest **1 December 2020**.
- Nominations must be accompanied with this form.

Selection procedure

- A RIMLS jury will decide upon winner based on a short 250 word motivation highlighting why the publication is groundbreaking. Motivations may cover:
 - o Contribution to new knowledge/theory and/or change in practice after the appearance of the publication, i.e. revolutionary aspect.
 - o Multidisciplinary nature of the publication, i.e. broadness of application
 - o Impact for scientific community.
 - Societal impact.
 - Expected long-term impact (>5 years).
 - Related patent(s)
- Publication based on original experimental data (not a review)
- Publication must be in print in 2020 (i.e. not in-press nor e-pub)
- First author PhD student or Postdoc within 4 years after promotion (NWO extension clause apply). PhD students must be registered in RIMLS PhD programme.
- RIMLS affiliation must mentioned in article.
